PAUL BUSSE GARDEN RAILWAY

ON DISPLAY THROUGH JANUARY 5, 2025

All aboard! *The Paul Busse Garden Railway* returns to the Grand Mallway. Explore four unique botanical themes on an enchanting and immersive scale, from Fairytale Land and Wild West Town to animal-themed models in Who Lives Here and European Travels.

Guests will wind their way through a miniature world of 51 botanical models made from all-natural plant material gathered in fields and forests near and far. Whirling overhead and below, the nine G-scale model trains move along the elegant shape of the track which totals 1,122 feet.

COLOR, FLY, BUTTERFLY


JUNE 1-NOVEMBER 17, 2024




THE FLUTTER RUN 5K
