ON DISPLAY THROUGH MARCH 9, 2025

Aloha! Inspired by the beauty of the Hawaiian Islands, Orchids will explore five iconic landscapes that capture the essence of Hawaii's natural beauty. From the towering volcanoes to the lush rainforests, each landscape reflects the unique topography, colorful plant life, and the cultural significance that defines this island paradise. Over 1,800 orchids are on display throughout the Conservatory, showcasing the tapestry of color and textures seen on the islands.
